### None smoking cottage

- ❖ The deposit is payable on booking. It is advisable to telephone to check availability of the dates required before sending your deposit. We will then reserve the dates for you for one week, but we must receive the deposit within that time. On receipt of the deposit we will confirm the booking.
- ❖ The balance is due four weeks before the holiday commences. Please make cheques payable to M + G Fell
- ❖ Holiday cancellations must be received in writing and will be acknowledged immediately.
- ❖ When a holiday is cancelled the deposit is forfeited. However, if cancellation is less than four weeks prior to the holiday, the visitor is liable for the balance owing unless the cottage is re-let. Insurance forms to cover you for this are sent out with the confirmation of booking please do use them.
- ❖ Please telephone the owners a couple of days before arrival to arrange collection of the key.
- ❖ The accommodation is available from **3pm** on the first day of the holiday, unless by prior arrangement with the owners. Visitors are requested to vacate the cottage by **10am** on the day of departure.
- ❖ Visitors are requested to keep the cottage and all fixtures and fittings in the same condition as at the commencement of holiday, and to keep the cottage clean and tidy. **All breakages and damage must be paid for.**
